When	Focus	What to do
Days 1–7	Hiragana	Learn & read all hiragana; write each character correctly.
Days 8–14	Katakana	Learn & read all katakana; start reading loanwords.
Days 15–18	Core grammar 1	AはBです、negatives、questions with か.
Days 19–24	Particles	は・が・を・に・で・の — one per day, then mixed drills.
Days 25–30	Verbs (masu-form)	Present, negative, past; 20 everyday verbs. Learn the ます forms.
Days 31–36	First kanji	N5 kanji 1–40; write with stroke order, attach a word each.
Days 37–42	Adjectives	い- and な-adjectives; describing things & feelings.
Days 43–48	Te-form	The て-form: requests, progressive (～ています), linking actions.
Days 49–54	Kanji + vocab	N5 kanji 41–103; grow vocabulary to ~600 words.
Days 55–58	Reading & listening	Short passages daily; slow listening 15 min/day.
Days 59–60	Mock test	Full N5-style practice; review every mistake.
